ADRIFT

Close on the heels of the release of the new CD from BRADY, STEWART, GREEN & YOUNG comes the solo effort from STEPHEN BRADY, *Adrift*. Without the ladies, Stephen has a more country – less folk approach. Of the fifteen tracks, six are duets and in several more the harmonies are significant. ANTHONY TAYLOR joins Stephen for *Scars*, an exceptional rendition of the great country track. *Adam's Song* is a sweetly delicate duet with VICTORIA BAILLIE. *Crossing Muddy Water*, with LIANNA ROSE adds a fresh bluegrass flavour. BEC WILLIS joins Stephen for *Down To My Soul*. JO MEMBERY adds her ethereal vocals to *Love's Endless War*. *No Time For Sorrow* is a pretty collaboration with JENNY MARIE LANG. *Not down as a 'duet'*, but essentially one with musical partner LIZ GREEN, *Just Like You* is charming. KAREN O'SHEA's beautiful harmonies grace *Like I Used To Do*. Stephen Brady can be justifiably proud of this skilfully crafted album.
